FROM MAYOR SCOTT SCHRECEGOST:

We wish all of you a happy, healthy and prosperous New Year!

The Village of Celoron's Consolidated Funding Application for the construction of a new amenities building was approved in the amount of \$382,680. This is in addition to the \$354,220 that was received in last year's round of funding for the repair of the break wall and construction of a board walk and kayak/canoe launch.

CDBG FUNDS: The Village of Celoron applied again for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds through the New York State Office of Community Renewal to assist low and moderate income homeowners in the Village of Celoron with necessary home repairs such as roofs, windows, furnaces, insulation, electrical upgrades, etc. Unfortunately, we were not successful this year. We will try again next year.

CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS PARTY: At our 2017 Children's Christmas Party hosted by The Resource Center, Santa gave out 78 presents to the children, or grandchildren, of Village residents. We all say, "Thank You!" to: The Resource Center (for making this event possible by providing the spacious auditorium and party refreshments); Santa (for making the long trip from the North Pole to Celoron for our special event); and Deputy Mayor Mary Keeney (who shopped for and wrapped all the gifts).

CURBSIDE GARBAGE & RECYCLABLE COLLECTION: Enclosed is a copy of the 2018 Curbside Garbage & Recyclable Calendar. The schedule is different this year. We are no longer recycling glass because there is no market for it. Glass should be placed in the regular garbage. We will now be collecting plastics twice a month. Since December 25th is a Tuesday, garbage will be collected on Wednesday, December 26, 2018. This is also true for January 1, 2019 with the garbage being collected on Wednesday, January 2, 2019. Also, please note that no recycling will be collected on December 18, 2018.

WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS: The Village Highway Department has been busy keeping the streets and sidewalks plowed. Just a friendly reminder: The Village of Celoron does not allow roadside parking between the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. from November 1st to April 1st. The Village of Celoron takes its responsibility of snowplowing seriously and asks that you cooperate with the Village's attempt to serve the entire Village. Therefore, all persons with, or access to, driveways and/or garages are expected to park off the roadways in order to facilitate the required task of snowplowing Celoron's streets. The Village will adhere to the following Winter Parking procedure: A note on the car windshield will be your first and only warning of a violation of the Winter Parking Regulations. A second violation during this winter season could cause, at your expense, your vehicle or anything else parked illegally to be towed.
