FROM MAYOR SCOTT SCHRECENGOST:

Unfortunately, the Rib-Fest event had to be cancelled for this year. There will be concerts in the park on Wednesday evenings for the month of July. The band schedule will be listed at a later date. The Dragon Boat races will continue in the park on August 8th, 2026. Come down and enjoy the music, vendors and the races this summer.

We are currently working on a new water contract with the Board of Public Utilities. Currently, Celoron residents pay a 50% premium above what City of Jamestown residents pay. The Board of Public Utilities is seeking to double that premium resulting in Village residents paying twice as much as City of Jamestown residents. We are hoping to keep the increase to a minimum.

The Easter Egg Hunt will be held at Lucille Ball Memorial Park on April 4th, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. sharp. Registration for the Bike Drawings will be from 9:00 a.m. - 9:45 a.m. You must be registered and present to win. SPRING CLEAN-UP: We will be having our annual Spring Clean-Up on Saturday May 16, 2026 from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. As in the past, there will be dumpsters located at the Village Highway Garage, 50 Gifford Avenue. You may bring items you wish to dispose of with these three exceptions:

1. The county landfill will no longer accept any electronic devices (televisions, computer, VCR's, etc.)
2. Tires-All types
3. Refrigerators must be tagged that all Freon has been removed before the Village can accept them.

CODE ENFORCEMENT: Please take advantage of Spring Clean-Up on May 16th, 2026. Some properties are looking a little rough. Several properties have been cited and scheduled for court appearances. If you have unregistered or junk vehicles, you will be getting a notice. Please get rid of them or use an appropriate auto cover. A tarp will not be accepted! You are only permitted to have one unregistered vehicle. Code Enforcement Officer Alan Gustafson currently does not have any set office hours. He can be reached at 716/499-7190. Just a reminder, **Building Permits are required for Sheds, Roofs, Fences, Pools, Additions, etc.** Building Permit applications are available at the Celoron Village Hall, or on the Village Website at www.celoronny.org. Completed applications should be submitted to the Village Hall, and will be reviewed for approval by Mr. Gustafson.
