

FROM THE MAYOR: Thank you to our Highway Department for all their efforts in keeping our streets salted and plowed during this winter season. We have a limited supply of at home covid tests for Village residents at Village Hall. We are looking for someone to clean the restroom this summer and for a utility worker, with a CDL for the highway department. Applications are available in Village Hall. There are also openings on the Zoning Board of Appeals and the Planning Board. Please let me know if you are interested in serving on them. We are planning on holding summer concerts again in July. Keep an eye out for updates on who will be performing.

EASTER EGG HUNT: The Children's Easter Egg Hunt will be held on Saturday, April 16th in Lucille Ball Memorial Park. Registration to enter the bike drawing will be held from 9:00 am to 9:45 am. The egg hunt starts at 10 am sharp.

<u>CODE ENFORCEMENT</u>: Remember that permits are required for roofs, fences, pools, additions, etc. It is now a requirement that all pools installed after 2006 must have an alarm and must be inspected by the Code Enforcement Officer. Pools must also have either a 48" high fence or the pool itself must be 48" high. We have some flyers listing the requirements in Village Hall that you can pick up.

<u>**CURBSIDE GARBAGE & RECYCLABLE COLLECTION:</u>** Our highway guys are spending too much time resorting cardboard. The only cardboard that is recyclable is shipping boxes (corrugated cardboard) – <u>ALL</u> others such as cereal boxes, pop & beer containers, paper towel rolls, etc. are not recyclable. Please put in regular garbage. Thank you.</u>

- 1. The county landfill will no longer accept any electronic devices (televisions, computers, VCR's).
- 2. Tires All Types

Look inside the house and also start cleaning up the yards. Find a friend who has a truck, or ask for help. Help us take another step in beautifying our Village.

2022 BRUSH DISPOSAL: For your convenience, you may dispose of grass clippings, leaves, twigs, brush and small branches (small enough to be handled by one person) this summer at the designated area of the Village of Celoron Highway Garage, 50 Gifford Avenue, every other Monday from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. <u>Please empty</u> your containers, boxes or bags of brush. (NO BAGS, BOXES or CONTAINERS may be discarded there.) Maximum of one cubic yard per vehicle is allowed. (Landscape experts suggest that grass clippings be left on your lawn.)
